

FALSE! Here's why:





Probability of Success

- What is the chance that these ideas will work together? Slim to none.
- What is the chance that these ideas may suggest changes in other areas? High.
- What is the chance that these ideas may be in conflict? Extremely high!







The real problems start during the implementation of *all* the ideas that were developed by *all* the committees because *all* the ideas are <u>often</u> in **conflict**!







Why so much **conflict**?













Because *all* the ideas were constructed in isolation and without consideration of each other!





There is a Better Way



- Form one committee made up of a person from each functional group and find the *real problem* that impacts all areas of the organization.
- 2. Develop *breakthrough solution* via input from one committee made up of people from across the organization.
- 3. Create a **buy-in plan** to enhance solution implementation.
- 4. Stop thinking technology is the solution.
- 5. Understand solving complex business problems is an *ongoing process* (go back to Step #1).
